POSITION DESCRIPTION

THE PROGRAM

BaMidbar Wilderness Therapy guides Jewish young adults (18-26) on therapeutic expeditions. BaMidbar's program utilizes the wilderness environment as a vehicle to promote therapeutic growth of students, in a process that is individualized for each student, and is guided and directed by a licensed mental health professional. BaMidbar's clinical intervention and wilderness experience are provided through a Jewish framework. BaMidbar's programming is guided by four core values: *kavod*, honor, dignity, and respect for ourselves and others; *simcha*, finding joyful Jewish meaning in every aspect of our lives; *tzmicha ishit*, accepting the challenges of personal transformation and growth; and *kehillah*, the power of an inclusive and supportive community. BaMidbar Wilderness Therapy is a program of the non-profit Ramah in the Rockies.

Position Type: Part-time

Schedule: As needed, typically on Wednesday's.

Location: Denver

Salary: \$20/hour

POSITION PURPOSE: BaMidbar Wilderness Therapy is looking for Denver-based drivers to support student transportation to and from the ranch, especially on arrival days. Arrival days are typically on Wednesday's. As a therapeutic program, BaMidbar ensures drivers are always working in pairs, and never alone with students.

Airport pick-ups include:

- Picking up a rental car from Avis in Englewood,
- Driving to the airport to meet incoming students
- Driving students to the Ramah in the Rockies ranch, 90 minutes southwest of Denver. Drivers may have to accompany student to a sports physical along the way
- Upon arriving at the ranch, driver may be requested to work with the Logistics Coordinator to support gear and outfitting of students.
- If student group is on an off-site excursion location, drive student to the group after gear and outfitting is completed.
- Return rental car to Avis location.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must have a clean driving record and be able to pass a federal background check
- Must complete a 16-hour training, include the 14-hour Aegis Deescalation and Crisis Intervention certification.

LOCATION:

BaMidbar Wilderness Therapy is based at Ramah in the Rockies, a 360-acre ranch nestled in the pristine Pike and San Isabel National Forests. Ramah in the Rockies is 90 minutes from Denver, at an elevation of 8,000 feet.
